


# Daily Report 28/2020

4 February 2020<sup>1</sup>

#### **Summary**

- Compared with the previous 24 hours, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Small-arms fire was assessed as aimed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicles near government-controlled Yurivka and the non-government-controlled Kuibyshevskyi district of Donetsk city.
- The Mission continued monitoring the security situation at the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- It saw a mortar in violation of withdrawal lines in a non-government-controlled area of Luhansk region.
- It saw anti-tank mines near Orikhove and unexploded ordnance near Molodizhne.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at checkpoints in non-government-controlled Verkhnoshyrokivske, Zaichenko and Kreminets, all in Donetsk region.\*

### Ceasefire violations<sup>2</sup>





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (about 70), compared with the <u>previous 24 hours</u> (about 320 explosions). More than half of the ceasefire violations were recorded at southerly directions of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), at westerly directions of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk), at southerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk) and in areas north-north-west of Oleksandrivka (non-government-controlled, 20km south-west of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations (19, all of them explosions), compared with the <u>previous 24 hours</u> (about 180 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas east of Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

# Small-arms fire assessed as directed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicles near Yurivka and the Kuibyshevskyi district of Donetsk city

While conducting an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) flight near the western outskirts of the Kuibyshevskyi district of Donetsk city (non-government-controlled, 5km west of Donetsk city centre), the SMM heard five shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 2-3km north-north-west, assessed as directed at the UAV, which was flying about 1.5km north-north-west of the SMM's position. The SMM safely landed the UAV and left the area.\*

While conducting an SMM mini-UAV flight on the southern outskirts of Yurivka (government-controlled, 35km north of Donetsk), the SMM heard seven shots of small-arms fire at an assessed distance of 1.5km east, assessed as directed at the UAV, which was flying about 1.5km east of the SMM's position. The SMM safely landed the UAV and left the area.\*

### Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>5</sup>

On 1 February, outside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted an anti-aircraft gun (ZU-23, 23mm) near the Prince Ihor Monument, about 1km south-east of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), assessed as belonging to the armed formations. The same UAV spotted an armoured combat vehicle (type undetermined) and an armoured personnel carrier (BTR-80) about 70m north of the north-eastern edge of the disengagement area, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 3 February, inside the disengagement area, the SMM saw up to seven members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge and their checkpoint south of it.

On the afternoon of 3 February, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded three undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 2-4km east, assessed as outside the **disengagement area near Zolote** but within 5km of its periphery. On the area's southern edge, the SMM saw two members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them).

On 31 January, on the eastern edge of the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted at least nine anti-tank mines and eight anti-personnel mines.

On the same day, outside the disengagement area, 50m east of its eastern edge, the same UAV spotted for the first time two 80m-long wires running in parallel east to west, insulated from the ground by wooden poles and attached to a green box at the eastern end.

On the same day, outside the disengagement area, the same UAV <u>again</u> spotted 16 anti-tank mines in a field about 100m north of its northern edge, near a position of the armed formations. On 2 February, outside the disengagement area, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted about 20 anti-tank mines north of the road between Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) and Viktorivka (non-government-controlled, 42km south-west of Donetsk).

On 3 February, inside the disengagement area, the SMM saw that a trench (about 300m-long) about 400m west of the area's eastern edge and about 50m south of its northern edge had been filled-in or covered over (in the same area where the SMM <u>previously</u> saw four men in military-style attire walking). On the same day, positioned 1.3km north of Petrivske, the SMM heard 14 shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-1.5km south, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum. The Mission observed a mortar in violation of withdrawal lines in a non-government-controlled area of Luhansk region (for further details, see the table below).

### Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone<sup>6</sup>

On 31 January, an SMM mini-UAV spotted four craters in a cultivated field and a crater in front of a residential house, which had a hole in its roof, on the north-western edge of Sentianivka (formerly Frunze, non-government-controlled, 44km west of Luhansk) (not seen in imagery from 31 October 2019). The SMM could not assess the type of weapons used or direction of fire.

On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV spotted another seven craters in a field and a crater near residential houses on the north-western edge of Holubivske (non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk) (not seen in imagery from 21 November 2019). The SMM could not assess the type of weapons used or direction of fire. About 100m further north-west, the same UAV spotted probable ongoing improvement works of a trench stretching from north to south over about 30m and piles of wooden planks nearby.

On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV spotted a new position of the armed formations about 2km north of Berezivske (non-government-controlled, 53km north-west of Luhansk) (not seen in imagery from 21 November 2019).

On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV spotted four Ukrainian Armed Forces soldiers expanding a position, with sand bags and wooden construction material next to it, as well as an underground shelter under construction nearby, all about 2km south-south-west of Novotoshkivske (government-controlled, 53km west of Luhansk) (not seen in imagery from 21 November 2019).

On the same day, in Petrivske, an SMM mini-UAV spotted ongoing fortification works to a previously reported position of the armed formations on the main street. About 1km north of Petrivske, the UAV spotted an infantry fighting vehicle (BMP-2).

# Presence of anti-tank mines near government-controlled Orikhove and of unexploded ordnance near non-government-controlled Molodizhne

On 1 February, an SMM mini-UAV spotted approximately 110 anti-tank mines (the SMM was not able to assess whether recently laid or not), laid out in three rows running from north to south over 100m, about 2km south of Orikhove (government-controlled, 57km north-west of Luhansk), assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 3 February, the Mission saw for the first time a piece of unexploded ordnance, assessed as a possible tailfin of an anti-tank guided missile, on the ground about 5m north-west of a checkpoint of the armed formations 1.7km south-west of Molodizhne (non-government-controlled, 63km north-west of Luhansk) and around 5m north-east of road T-0505.

On the same day, the SMM saw for the first time a mine hazard sign on the eastern side of a local road near an inhabited house in Orlivske (government-controlled, 82km south of Donetsk).

### SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to enable repairs to water wells near Slovianoserbsk (non-government-controlled, 28km north-west of Luhansk). It continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitor the security situation around the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

## Border areas outside government control

While at a border crossing point near Dovzhanske (84km south-east of Luhansk) for about 25 minutes, the SMM saw seven pedestrians (four men and a woman, around 35 years old, and two children around two years old) entering Ukraine. It also observed a car with Russian Federation licence plates, three covered cargo trucks and a bus with "LPR" plates, and five pedestrians (men, around 30 years old) exiting Ukraine.

While at a pedestrian border crossing point near Novoborovytsi (79km south of Luhansk) for about five minutes, the SMM saw no cross-border traffic.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

# \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such

response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 1 February 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

### Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage westwards, citing "engineering works". While present, the SMM saw civilian traffic proceeding through the checkpoint in both directions.
- At a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities". While present, the SMM saw civilian traffic proceeding through the checkpoint in both directions.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

#### Delay:

- On two occasions, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske, a member of the armed formations allowed the SMM passage after about 20 minutes of waiting.
- At a checkpoint about 5km west of Mariupol city centre (government-controlled, 102km south of Donetsk), a Ukrainian Armed Forces soldier allowed the SMM passage after 17 minutes of waiting, citing "a lack of instructions from his superiors".

#### Conditional:

- At a checkpoint east of Kreminets (non-government-controlled, 16km south-west of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations allowed the SMM to proceed only after inspecting its trailer.

### Other impediments:

- While conducting a mini-UAV flight over areas near Yurivka (government-controlled, 35km north of Donetsk), the SMM heard shots of small-arms fire, assessed as directed at its UAV (see above).
- While conducting a mini-UAV flight over areas near the Kuibyshevskyi district of Donetsk city (non-government-controlled, 5km west of Donetsk city centre), the SMM heard shots of small-arms fire, assessed as directed at its UAV (see above).


