

# Daily Report 85/2020


10 April 2020<sup>1</sup>

#### **Summary**

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and fewer in Luhansk region.
- In Donetsk region, small-arms fire was assessed as directed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) flying over areas near Petrivske and Hranitne, one of which was lost and assessed to have crashed near Petrivske.\*
- Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage towards nongovernment-controlled areas at checkpoints in Donetsk region and at a checkpoint in Luhansk region.\*
- The Mission recorded two projectiles in flight inside the disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska.
- It continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Zolote and Petrivske, and saw a person inside a trench near the northern edge of the Zolote disengagement area.
- The SMM monitored and facilitated adherence to localized ceasefires to enable repairs to and maintenance and construction of civilian infrastructure on both sides of the contact line, as well as demining activities.
- The Mission continued following up on the situation of civilians amid the COVID-19 outbreak, including at entry-exit checkpoints and their corresponding checkpoints in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.\*

### Ceasefire violations<sup>2</sup>



### Map of recorded ceasefire violations



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 100), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 90 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at westerly directions of Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk), at northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), and in areas south, east, and south-south-east of Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (12), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 30 explosions). Most ceasefire violations, including almost all explosions, were recorded in areas north-east of Prychepylivka (government-controlled, 50km north-west of Luhansk) and east of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

### Small-arms fire assessed as directed at SMM mini-UAVs near Petrivske and Hranitne

While positioned about 2km north of Petrivske to conduct a mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) flight, the SMM heard about 20 shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-2km south, assessed as aimed at its UAV, which was flying about 1km south. The SMM lost control of the UAV, which was assessed to have crashed, and was unable to retrieve it.\*

On the same day, while positioned near the south-western outskirts of Hranitne (government-controlled, 60km south of Donetsk) to conduct a mini-UAV flight, the SMM heard three shots and a burst of small-arms fire at an assessed distance of 1km east, assessed as aimed at its UAV, which was flying about 1km east. The SMM recovered the UAV and left the area.\*

# Members of the armed formations continued to deny SMM passage at checkpoints along the contact line in Donetsk and Luhansk regions

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the Mission passage at checkpoints along official crossing routes in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions. These restrictions constitute an impediment to the implementation of the Mission's mandate.<sup>5</sup>

At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), three members of the armed formations (two visibly armed) denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "quarantine-related reasons". The SMM also saw for the first time three anti-tank mines on a road near the checkpoint (see below). The members of the armed formations said that they would not remove the mines for the SMM.\*

At a checkpoint near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), five members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "quarantine restrictions".\*

Members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas at their checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), citing "COVID-19 restrictions".\*

### Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>6</sup>

On the evening of 8 April, the SMM camera in Stanytsia Luhanska (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk) recorded two projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 200-500m north-east, assessed as inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska**. The last ceasefire violation inside the disengagement area was recorded on 3 October 2019.

On the same day, outside the disengagement area, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted three armoured combat vehicles (one BMP variant and two undetermined variants), about 100m north of the area's northern edge (see table below).

On 9 April, inside the disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska and about 100m west of the new section of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge, near the northern bank of the Siverskyi Donets river, the SMM saw a fire burning. A Ukrainian Armed Forces officer of the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) told the SMM that the fire had started overnight and that its cause was unknown.

On 8 April, inside the **disengagement area near Zolote**, an SMM mini-UAV spotted a person in a trench about 150m south of the its northern edge and about 500m west of its eastern edge. The UAV <u>again</u> spotted 55 anti-tank mines (probable TM-62) laid in fields south of the railway tracks east and west of road T-1316, assessed as belonging to the armed formations. On the same day, outside the disengagement area, an SMM mini-UAV spotted two probable infantry fighting vehicles (BMP variants) near the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces about 200m north of the disengagement area (see table below).

On 9 April, while positioned at two locations near the disengagement area near Zolote, the SMM heard 12 undetermined explosions, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. Throughout the day, the SMM saw four members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On 9 April, while positioned at three locations near the **disengagement area near Petrivske**, the SMM heard about 115 shots of small-arms fire, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. The SMM also assessed some of the shots as aimed at its UAV, which was lost and assessed to have crashed (see above).

#### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission saw four weapons in violation of withdrawal lines in government- and non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region, including a tank near a residential area of Novohryhorivka (non-government-controlled, 61km north-east of Donetsk) (for further details, see table below).

### Indications of military and military-type presence inside the security zone<sup>7</sup>

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles in government- and non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions (for further details, see the table below).

### Presence of anti-tank mines near Vodiane and Verkhnoshyrokivske

On 7 April, an SMM mid-range UAV again spotted about 100 anti-tank mines, part of larger minefields, in fields near Vodiane (government-controlled, 94km south of Donetsk) and across road T-0519, all assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces (for previous observations, see SMM Daily Reports of 13 January 2020 and 6 March 2020).

On 9 April, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske, the SMM saw for the first time three anti-tank mines (TM-62) on a wooden plank near the checkpoint, in the middle of a road leading towards Verkhnoshyrokivske. Members of the armed formations said they would not remove the mines for the SMM (see above).\*

# SMM facilitation of construction of and repairs to critical civilian infrastructure and demining activities

The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable vegetation clearance, inspection and maintenance of railway tracks near Vilkhove (government-controlled, 22km north-east of Luhansk); repairs to water infrastructure near Pankivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north of Luhansk), to an electrical substation at the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk), and to a water pipeline in Zaitseve (50km north-east of Donetsk); construction of a powerline near the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) near Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk); and demining activities in Krasnyi Yar (non-government-controlled, 12km north-east of Luhansk).

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS) (15km north of Donetsk). During the day on 9 April, while positioned at four locations near the DFS, the SMM heard about 60 undetermined explosions, including two assessed as impacts, as well as bursts and shots of heavy-machine-gun and small-arms fire, all assessed as within a 5km radius of the DFS.

# Situation of civilians and measures at entry-exit checkpoints and corresponding checkpoints to counter COVID-19 outbreak

In Luhansk region, the SMM saw that the EECP in Stanytsia Luhanska and the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge remained closed. At the EECP, the Mission saw three men (mixed ages) waiting to exit government-controlled areas.

In Donetsk region, the SMM saw that the EECPs near Novotroitske (government-controlled, 36km south-west of Donetsk) and Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk), as well as checkpoints of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske and Olenivka, remained closed.

At a checkpoint near Taramchuk (government-controlled, 29km south-west of Donetsk), a woman (in her sixties) told the SMM that she was a resident of the nearby settlement of Stepne (government-controlled, 29km south-west of Donetsk) and had travelled to Taramchuk to visit the graves of her relatives. She added that Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel at the checkpoint had denied her entrance to the settlement. At the checkpoint, Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel told the SMM that, since 6 April, only residents of Taramchuk were permitted to enter due to "quarantine."

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

## \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines and unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example see SMM Daily Report 28 March 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

### Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), two members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "COVID-19 restrictions."
- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), three members of the armed formations (two visibly armed) denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "quarantine-related reasons." The SMM also saw for the first time three antitank mines in the middle of a road leading towards Verkhnoshyrokivske. The members of the armed formations said that they would not remove the mines for the SMM.
- At a checkpoint near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), five members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "quarantine restrictions."

*Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:* 

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

### Other impediments:

- On the evening of 8 April, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over government-controlled areas between Roty (66km north-east of Donetsk) and Novozvanivka (70km west of Luhansk).
- On 9 April, while conducting an SMM mini-UAV flight near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), the SMM heard shots of small-arms fire, assessed as aimed at the UAV. The SMM lost control of the UAV, which was assessed to have crashed, and was unable to retrieve it.
- On 9 April, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Hranitne (government-controlled, 60km south of Donetsk). Shortly thereafter, the SMM heard a burst and shots of small-arms fire, assessed as aimed at the UAV.


