
# Daily Report 241/2021

14 October 2021<sup>1</sup>

## **Summary**

- In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded 230 ceasefire violations, including 96 explosions. In the previous reporting period, it recorded 244 ceasefire violations in the region.
- In Luhansk region, the Mission recorded 95 ceasefire violations, including 33 explosions. In the previous reporting period, it recorded 134 ceasefire violations in the region.
- The SMM continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.\* It recorded ceasefire violations inside the disengagement area near Petrivske.
- The Mission facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable the operation and repair of critical civilian infrastructure, as well as vegetation clearance.
- The SMM continued following up on the situation of civilians, including at three entry-exit checkpoints and four corresponding checkpoints of the armed formations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.<sup>2</sup>
- The Mission's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at checkpoints of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge, on the southern edge of the disengagement area near Zolote and at a checkpoint near the disengagement area near Petrivske. Its unmanned aerial vehicles again experienced instances of jamming.\*



## Map of recorded ceasefire violations



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded 230 ceasefire violations, including 96 explosions (three impacts and 93 undetermined). The majority of ceasefire violations occurred north-east of Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), as well as inside and near the disengagement area near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) (see below). In the <u>previous reporting period</u>, the Mission recorded 244 ceasefire violations in the region.

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded 95 ceasefire violations, including 33 undetermined explosions. The majority of ceasefire violations occurred at south-easterly direction of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk), as well as in areas near the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below). In the <u>previous reporting period</u>, the Mission recorded 134 ceasefire violations in the region, almost all of which also occurred close to the disengagement area near Zolote.

Following agreement reached at the meeting of the Trilateral Contact Group (TCG) on 22 July 2020 regarding Measures to strengthen the ceasefire, from 00:01 on 27 July 2020 until the end of the reporting period, the SMM has recorded at least 64,175 ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions (including 17,597 explosions, 12,982 projectiles in flight, 285 muzzle flashes, 259 illumination flares and at least 33,052 bursts and shots).

## Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>6</sup>

Inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the Mission saw two members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) south of the repaired span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk).

On the evening of 12 October, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded two projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 4-6km east. During the day of 13 October, while positioned at two locations, the SMM heard one undetermined explosion and 17 shots of small-arms fire. On the evening of 13 October, while on the northern edge of Popasna, the Mission heard nine undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 4-5km east. Also on the evening of 13 October, the SMM camera in Popasna recorded three projectiles in flight and one muzzle flash at an assessed range of 4-6km east-south-east. All these ceasefire violations were assessed as outside the **disengagement area near Zolote** but within 5km of its periphery.

On 13 October, near the checkpoint of the armed formations south of the disengagement area near Zolote, the Mission saw ten members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them). It then saw seven of them carrying prodding devices, enter the area, walk on road T-1316 to about 350m north of its southern edge and four of them returning. Shortly after, inside the disengagement area, near its southern edge, the SMM also observed a minivan and eight workers (one woman and seven men, in their forties to fifties) arrive, seven of the workers enter the area with grass cutters and three of them returning. Later on the same day, the Mission saw that vegetation on both sides of road T-1316 between the southern edge of the disengagement area and about 340m north of its southern edge had been cleared (see below).

The SMM again saw the seven previously observed containers located south of the disengagement area's southern edge and inside the area, as well as the previously reported underground structure inside the area.

On the evening and night of 12-13 October, the SMM camera 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) recorded one undetermined explosion and two projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 2-4km east-south-east, assessed as inside the **disengagement area near Petrivske**. During the same evening and night, it also recorded three undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 3-5km east, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery, and one undetermined explosion and 38 projectiles in flight at assessed ranges of 3-5km east-south-east and south-east, unable to be assessed as either inside or outside the disengagement area.

During the day on 13 October, while positioned about 2km east of Bohdanivka, the Mission observed a calm situation near the disengagement area.\*

## Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

In violation of withdrawal lines, the Mission saw one surface-to-air missile system near a residential area and one anti-tank guided missile system, both in government-controlled areas of Donetsk region. In a non-government controlled area, at an airfield near Peremozhne (19km south of Luhansk), it saw one multiple launch rocket system, five howitzers and one anti-tank gun.

Beyond withdrawal lines but outside designated storage sites, the SMM observed two surface-to-air missile systems, two mortars and two tanks at the abovementioned airfield. (For further information, see the tables below.)

## Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone

The Mission observed eight armoured combat vehicles in government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, as well as four infantry fighting vehicles and one probable anti-aircraft gun in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk region. ## Presence of anti-tank mines near government-controlled Luhanske, Donetsk region

On 12 October, about 5km south-east of Luhanske (government-controlled, 59km north-east of Donetsk), an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted 14 previously reported anti-tank mines laid across road M-03, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces. (For previous observations in the area see SMM Daily Report of 1 June 2021.)

## SMM facilitation - the operation and repairs of critical civilian infrastructure

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS) (15km north of Donetsk) and monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to enable repairs to the

roofs of its buildings. While positioned at two locations near the station, the SMM heard nine undetermined explosions, assessed as inside a 5km radius of the DFS.

The Mission also monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to enable inspection and repairs to water infrastructure in Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) and to enable vegetation clearance on both sides of road T-1316 south of the railway bridge in the disengagement area near Zolote.

## Situation at entry-exit checkpoints and corresponding checkpoints

In Donetsk region, the SMM observed that the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk) was closed.

In Luhansk region, the Mission observed that the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) near Stanytsia Luhanska and the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge were open, with people queueing to travel in both directions.

While at the EECP, the SMM observed a civilian van and five workers (men, in their forties to fifties) with vegetation-trimming equipment, shovels and brooms clearing vegetation on both sides of the road between the EECP and the repaired span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge. (For previous observations in the area, see SMM Daily Report of 13 October 2021).

The Mission noted that the EECPs near Zolote and Shchastia (government-controlled, 20km north of Luhansk) were open, but that the corresponding checkpoints of the armed formations south of the disengagement area near Zolote and 3km south-east of the bridge in Shchastia were closed.

The SMM continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi, and Kyiv.

## ${ m *Restrictions}$ of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Minsk agreements have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the government (for example, see SMM Daily Report of 13 October 2021). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

#### Denials:

- At a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards the bridge, referring to a lack of prior coordination with those in control.
- At a checkpoint on the southern edge of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations denied the Mission passage south, referring to the SMM's safety.
- At a checkpoint north of Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage south towards the disengagement area near Petrivske, citing "ongoing de-mining activities in the area".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

### Delays:

- At a checkpoint near Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations allowed the SMM passage south-west towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) only after about 31 minutes of waiting, citing "ongoing engineering works". The Mission was en route to follow up on reports of damage to civilian properties.

## Other impediments:7

- SMM mini-UAVs experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, during five flights: twice each while flying over areas near Tonenke (government-controlled, 19km north-west of Donetsk) and near Novotoshkivske (government-controlled, 53km west of Luhansk), and once near Orikhove (government-controlled, 57km north-west of Luhansk).
