Organizational Modalities

The OSCE Secretariat is pleased to inform you about the organizational modalities for the *Security Days* **2019** Conference on "The OSCE and the Sustainable Development Goals", taking place in Vienna on 4 June **2019**.

1. Venue

On 4 June, the Conference will take place at the <u>Vienna International Centre</u> (C building, 7th floor, Boardroom CR-3), Wagramer Str. 5, 1400 Vienna, Austria. **Please see floorplan as Annex II.**

2. Final Agenda and Organizational Modalities

The agenda and additional material will be updated regularly on the web page. The final agenda will be circulated prior to the event. The Conference will be conducted in English, with no interpretation.

3. Accreditation/Participation

Participation requires the submission of the Registration form beforehand. Participants are kindly requested to fill in the Registration form and to send it to ena.bektasevic@osce.org, not later than 24 May 2019. Please see Annex 1.

Access to the Vienna International Centre will be granted only to registered participants. Registered participants will then be sent further instructions and links to register with the Vienna International Centre, and upload all the information and photos. Only participants who complete the full registration process will be granted access cards to the VIC and be able to attend the event.

Grounds passes must be worn visibly at all times in the Vienna International Centre. All persons and their bags and briefcases will be screened at the entrance to the Centre.

We highly encourage representatives of the OSCE participating States, academia, think tanks, NGOs, media and students to attend.

4. Discussion Format

The Conference will be conducted in English with no interpretation.

5. Transportation

Participants are kindly requested to make their own travel and accommodation arrangements. These costs will not be paid for by the OSCE.

Taxis:

Taxis can be found in front of the arrival building of the airport. The fare depends on the destination in Vienna and is approx. \in 40.00 - \in 50.00.

Trains:

a) City Airport Train (CAT) – to Vienna "Wien-Mitte – Landstraße/Hauptstraße" with access to the Underground (U-Bahn Lines 3 and 4) and taxis.

Price: € 14.00 one way and € 19.00 return; if purchased online - € 11.00 one way and € 17.00 return.

Schedule: every ½ hour. Trip: 16 min. non-stop.

b) Schnellbahn (S1, S2 or S7) – Airport to Vienna "Wien-Mitte – Landstraße/Hauptstraße" with direct access to the Underground (U3 and U4) and taxis.

Price: € 4.20 one way. Schedule: every ½ hour Trip: approx. 30 min.

Please pay attention to the "direction" (Wolkersdorf, Deutsch Wagram, Wien-Floridsdorf).

c) Vienna Center (Stephansplatz U1 or Schwedenplatz U1) to Vienna International Center – Undergound U1 line in the direction of Leopoldau stops at "Kaisermühlen/Vienna International Centre" station, in front of Gate 1 of the VIC.

Line 1185 going to Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz (access to U1 and U4),

line 1187 going to Bahnhof Meidling/Dörfelstrasse (access to S-Bahn and U6) and then further to Westbahnhof (access to U3 and U6)

Line 1183 going to Kagran via Vienna International Center (access to U1).
