DECISION No. 406 EXTENSION OF THE MANDATE OF THE BORDER MONITORING OPERATION OF THE OSCE MISSION TO GEORGIA

The Permanent Council,

Recalling its Decisions Nos. 334 of 15 December 1999, 335 of 20 January 2000, 346 of 13 April 2000 and 372 of 21 September 2000 concerning the expansion of the mandate of the OSCE Mission to Georgia to observe and report on movement across the border between Georgia and the Chechen Republic of the Russian Federation,

- Decides to prolong the border monitoring operation of the OSCE Mission to Georgia until 15 November 2001;
- Decides to revert to the size of the operation of 42 international personnel;
- Approves a supplementary budget in the amount of EUR 3,972,600 for the border monitoring operation (see Annex). The supplementary budget covers a period from 16 April to 15 November 2001 and will be implemented in accordance with the proposal submitted by the Secretary General on 21 March 2001 (PC.IFC/26/01).
