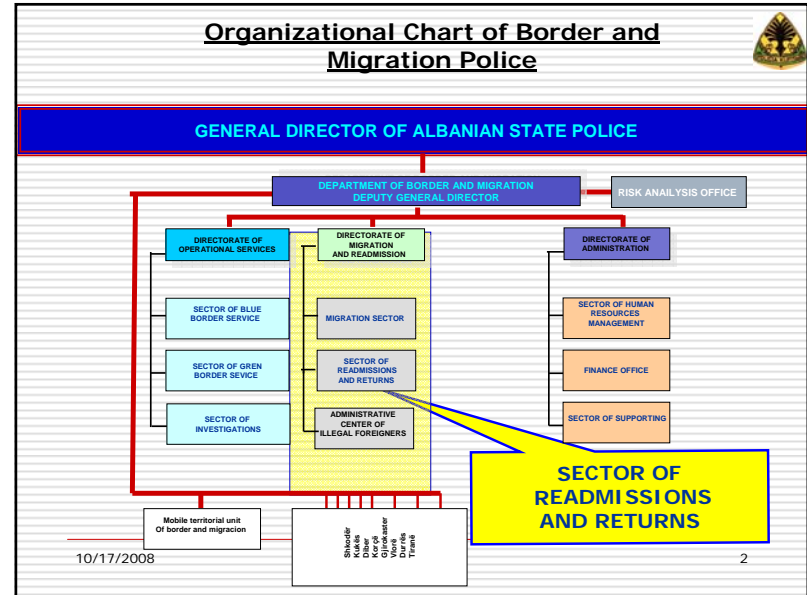

## MIGRATION MANAGEMENT

Includes: MoI, MfA, MoLSWEO

- MoLSWEO is responsible for the employment policies of the Albanian citizens. There is cooperation to point out the number of Albanians employed in other countries and the number of seasonal workers.
- Work is going on to set up a data bank in which MoI, MfA, MoLSWEO will be integrated, as well as data banks for respective structures.
- There are seasonal employment agreements with Italy and Greece. It has been signed also with Germany but not implemented yet. Only the agreement with Greece has been implemented.

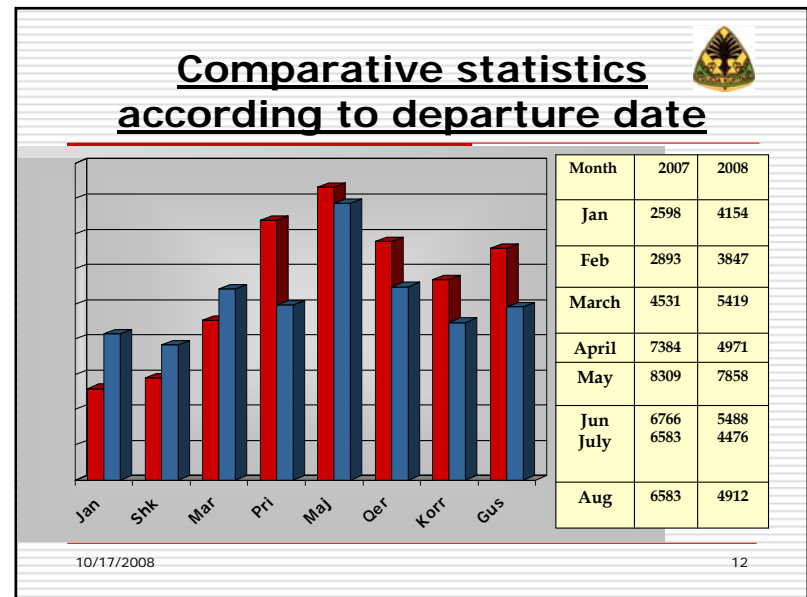




### Identified Victims
