



## **STATEMENT**

By the Delegation of the Republic of Moldova At the OSCE Permanent Council meeting, 21 July 2005 (on the OSCE PA resolution on Moldova)

Mr. Chairman,

I would like to thank Ambassador Nothelle for reacting to the previous statement of this Delegation on the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly session that took place earlier this month in Washington, D.C.

Without commenting on the text of the resolution or the ammendments to it, let me reiterate that the Moldovan Parliament also regretted the misunderstandings that occurred in the process of adoption of the resolution on the Republic of Moldova. In our view, cooperation and due negotiation were unfortunately missing among those who were engaged in this process. The concerns of the Moldovan parliamentarians are being transmitted to the PA bodies and in particular to the members of the ad-hoc Group on Moldova that, as mentioned by the Moldovan delegation, were supposed, by definition, to assess the situation in the country in order to enable all of us to move forward on the settlement track.

Let me express our hope that this case would be thoroughly reflected upon and given due consideration by the parliamentarians who have a crucial role in contributing to the success of the OSCE's activities.
