## STATEMENT ON OSCE ENGAGEMENT WITH KYRGYZSTAN

The Permanent Council,

Recalling its Statement of 15 June 2010 on the Situation in Kyrgyzstan (PC.DOC/1/10 of 15 June 2010), and in particular its offer to assist Kyrgyzstan upon its request in resolving the current crisis, preventing the spillover of tensions in the region, and in promoting post-conflict rehabilitation,

Takes note of the "Report From the OSCE Needs Assessment Mission on the Possible Deployment of An OSCE Police Task Force to Kyrgyzstan," and expresses its appreciation for the work done;

Expresses its readiness to consider the early deployment of a Police Task Force to Kyrgyzstan and calls for the swift conclusion of the negotiations with the competent Kyrgyzstani authorities so that the Permanent Council can take an appropriate decision.
