Founded in San Francisco back in 1969 DHL today is part of Deutsche Post DHL.


The Deutsche Post DHL Group generated revenue of more than 51 billion Euros in 2010.




Technical evolution in clearance


Information provided to customer

- Information on declared goods




Customs authorities validate shipment

Mandatory security clearance – accountability unclear?

Since the Export Control System declaration became mandatory customs authorities are unclear about whether they can still be held reliable for a shipment that already was export cleared in another EU country.

Consequently, first EU countries start to request additional local ECS declarations. This will lead to shipments that get multiple security checks while in transit through Europe. This then again is a waste of effort and loss in time.

Globally in some cases not even an agreement for a mutual acceptance of the security inspections exist.
