- The OSCE SMM Principal Deputy Chief Monitor Alexander Hug on 6-10 December 2015 visited Donetsk, Horlivka, Debaltseve, Pavlopil, Avdiivka and other locations in eastern Ukraine, where he met the SMM teams, representatives of the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination, and other interlocutors.
- Hug also went to the remains of Donetsk airport to inspect two sites "DPR"held Oktyabrsky Mine and government-controlled Avdiivka — that could serve as observation posts and also host stationary cameras for the SMM. See www.osce.org/ukraine-smm/208026
- The SMM observed that fighting continues in many areas of Donbas. The epicentre remains areas at and around Donetsk airport. On 8 December, SMM monitors recorded 92 explosions at the site.
- The SMM continued to observe weapons and military movements in the security zone or close to it. The SMM also observed heavy weapons inside agreed withdrawal lines.
