This report highlights the impact of activities carried out by the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) in 2023.








Comprehensive Support for Hate Crime Victims — Factsheet




The Right to Monitor Assemblies in the OSCE Region: Experiences from the Field


