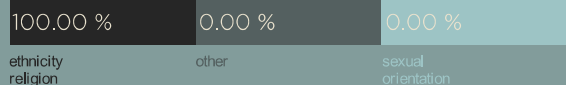

TYPES OF INCIDENTS

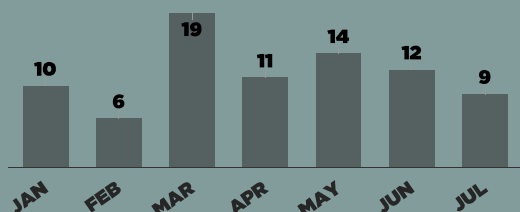


Incidents can consist of several acts. A single incident may be reported under multiple categories.

VICTIM CHARACTERISTICS:

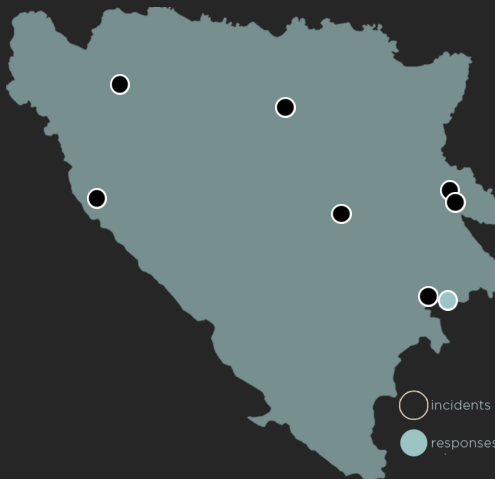

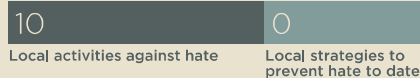
