

# General Project Overview




- The project is designed as a pilot project and focusing on the southern borders of Azerbaijan with Iran
- The project is funded by the EC
   TACIS Programme 2.200.000 Euro
- 3. Project Duration: 30 months
- Pilot sites are:
  - SBS Headquarter/Baku
  - Border Guards Training School
  - BCP Bilasuvar and Astara
  - Regional Detachments in Goytepe and Lenkaran

# **Inter-Agency Cooperation**

## **Specific objective of Inter-Agency Cooperation**

To achieve a comprehensive and effective border management system, all authorities involved in border issues need to cooperate at the **Local** (operational), **Regional** and **Central** level.

EU Guidelines for Integrated Border Management in the Western Balkans







#### Project activities on the local level

- Support the establishment of Joint Search Teams
  - joint training (risk profiling, joint/mobile controls at BCPs)
  - specialized equipment for vehicle search operations
  - joint/coordinated use of specialized equipment
     (x-ray, document inspection devices, vehicle/cargo scanners etc.)
- Promote individual **strengths** and **expertise** 
  - training of national document experts (*Train-the-trainer system*)
  - establishment of a regional *Customs Laboratory* for the analysis of suspicious substances (i.e. narcotics)
  - introduce *Risk Management Methods* for targeted control operations (Data Analysis Centre)





## Project activities on the regional/central level

#### **Project Coordination Meetings**

- strategic level participation
- exchange of information/programmes/strategies
- active involvement in procurement/training programs

#### Promote conclusion of *Inter-Agency Agreement*, to

- regulate exchange of information
- specify the areas of joint activities
- use jointly/share specialized equipment and expertise
- evaluate possibilities for cross-designation of tasks and responsibilities





#### Impact/perspectives for the project achievements

The achievements of the IBM project have been institutionalized, since

full ownership has been obtained by the project beneficiaries from the very beginning – installation/use of equipment, Border Guards
Training School (BGTS), updated SBS training Core Curriculum,
Regional Customs Laboratory, etc.

**sustainability** of the actions is ensured due to the allocation of national state funds for further replication of the project activities - Regional Customs Laboratory, Border Guards Academy, State Migration Service, re-construction of BCPs according to EU/international standards, etc.
