It is our pleasure to invite you to the Security Days expert roundtable entitled "Revitalizing Trust and Cooperation in Europe: Lessons of the Paris Charter" which is co-hosted by the Ministers of Foreign Affairs from the Czech Republic and the Republic of Slovakia. The event will take place in the Czernin Palace (Loretanske namesti 5) in Prague on 16 October 2020 at 9:00 (CET).
