- Immigration benefits and expectations
- Legal rights and responsibilities

- How to secure basic needs: housing, employment, transportation, health services, etc.
- Miscellaneous information: emergency services, instructions on use of telephone, holidays, etc.

- Housing services and information on tenant rights and responsibilities
- Medical services
- Employment services, accreditation
- Family law and gender relations: marriage, spousal and child rights,
- Drivers licenses and education
- Language and skills training
- Financial literacy, banking services

Community Oriented Services

- Information on numbers and characteristics, eligibility for services and work
- Interpretation and translation
- Community relations
- Anti-discrimination, anti-racism, antixenophobia activities
- Information and training for law enforcement personnel
- Information and training for education, health care and other service delivery systems
