Research Paper Requirements

All nominated researchers from the OSCE participating States and Partners for Co-operation are required to submit their research findings and relevant PowerPoint presentations to be delivered at the conference *by October 20, 2015*. Please, note that the working languages of the conference will be English and Russian.

The research papers must reflect a completed research work relevant to the topic of "Developing Innovative Solutions to Border Issues through New Technologies" and should be written in English and/or Russian. It should be between 6000-8000 words and must be structured as follows:

- Short bio (150 words)
- Abstract
- Introduction
- Literature Review
- Methodology
- Analysis and Findings
- Conclusion
