**DECISION No. 668
TRAINING ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME FOR
GEORGIAN BORDER GUARDS**

The Permanent Council,

Following the request of the Government of Georgia,

Decides to task the OSCE Mission to Georgia to implement the Training Assistance Programme (PC.DEL/108/05/Rev.6) in order to support the Georgian border guards in strengthening their border-management capacities and capabilities;

Further decides that:

- The implementation of the Programme is to start on 18 April 2005 and last until 31 December 2005;
- The Training Assistance Programme will not involve the conduct of monitoring activities;
- The dual-use equipment belonging to the former Border Monitoring Operation of the OSCE Mission to Georgia (as contained in the Annex) will be handed over to the Training Assistance Programme and will only be used in the Lilo training centre;

Requests the Secretary General, pending the adoption of the 2005 Unified Budget, to provide the budget allotment on the basis of PC.ACMF/38/05/Rev.1 for the Training Assistance Programme on a provisional basis, in line with Financial Regulation 3.04.
