EU statement on the OSCE Scales of Contribution

In keeping with our statement on September 24 in the Permanent

Council, the European Union has supported the discussions on the

OSCE scales of contribution this fall and would like to thank the

Greek Chairmanship for its efforts to reach an agreement on scales

before the end of the year.

As a revision of the current scales has proven elusive, the EU

support their roll-over. In this vein, we support the decision as

presented by the Chairmanship. While recognizing that the normal

duration of a decision on the scales of contribution is three years,

we have accepted the proposed one year roll-over in a spirit of

flexibility.

We look forward to continuing the discussion on scales in 2010.
