I would briefly remark that real and not illusory freedom of assembly implies also a positive obligation incumbent upon participating State to protect people when they assemble.

In fact, it is not satisfactory that States do not restrict themselves freedom of assembly. They have also a specific duty to protect assemblies from acts committed by private people and States should adopt all the initiatives necessary to prevent such incidents.

Quite often it happens that there are two concomitant assemblies near one from another with people expressing very different views. In such cases public authorities should do their best in order to prevent riots between two groups and to protect the safety of each group. Otherwise States legitimate the survival of the fittest.
