

### Highlighted

On 16 November, International Day for Tolerance. thirteen organizations from Prijedor, including both Serb and Bosniac veteran associations. signed a Memorandum of Cooperation and established "First Tolerance Priledor" Coalition against Hatred aiming to build community security through tolerance, and pledged to condemn all bias-motivated incidents and hate crimes.
