#### European Union statement on the escalation of the situation in South Ossetia (Georgia)

The European Union expresses its serious concern regarding the violent fighting taking place in South Ossetia (Georgia).

It reiterates its commitment to Georgia's sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity, within its internationally recognized land, sea and air borders.

It urges all parties to immediately cease hostilities and to resume negotiations without delay, in order to allow a political solution to the crisis.

The European Union fully supports the endeavors of the Chairman in Office of the OSCE, including those of its field mission, and calls upon all parties to cooperate with it without delay.

The European Union, in close consultation with all the protagonists, works towards a ceasefire in order to prevent the extension of the conflict.
