



**Statement
of the Permanent Representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
Ambassador Tomislav Leko, on the Address by the Minister for
Foreign Affairs of Andorra, H.E. Gilbert Saboya i Sunyé
at the 932nd Meeting of the OSCE Permanent Council
Vienna, 22 November 2012**

Mr. Chairperson,

While we fully subscribe with the statement of Cyprus on Behalf of the EU, I would like to add a couple of comments in my national capacity:

B&H warmly welcomes H.E. Mr. Gilbert Saboya i Sunyé at the Permanent Council.
