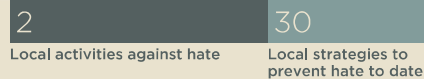

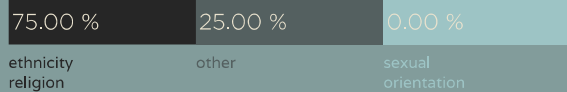

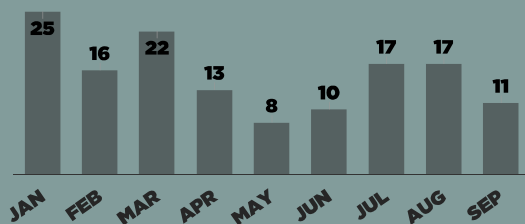

In September, the Jajce Team for CCAP Implementation held interactive workshops on the misuse of social networks to spread hatred and prejudices. 50 secondary school students learned about how to recognize and report the spread of hate speech on social media, as well as principles of ethical journalism and promotion of tolerance and co-existence among youth.
