The Chairperson, Belarus (PC.DEL/1500/15 OSCE+), Canada, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Turkey, Mongolia, Switzerland, the United States of America, Azerbaijan, Luxembourg-European Union, Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan, the Holy See, Moldova, Kazakhstan, San Marino and Ukraine expressed condolences to the families of those who lost their lives in the tragic crash of the Russian Metrojet Airbus 321 in Egypt.
