- 1. Dear Ambassador, the EU and its Member States thank you for this short yet meaningful report on the Structured Dialogue.
- Following the Hamburg Declaration and launched in 2017, the Structured Dialogue
  was based on consensus of all 57 participating States. Yet, after Russia's full scale
  war of aggression against Ukraine, there is currently no scope for meetings at 57
  in this format.
