**DECISION No. 1369  
APPROVAL OF THE 2020 UNIFIED BUDGET**

The Permanent Council,

I. Acting in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Financial Regulations and Permanent Council Decision No. 553 of 27 June 2003,

1. Approves the 2020 Unified Budget contained in Annex I;
2. Approves the 2020 Unified Budget Post Table contained in Annex II;

II. Taking into account relevant Ministerial Council Decisions, *inter alia*, No. 18/06 on further strengthening the effectiveness of OSCE executive structures and No. 19/06 on strengthening the effectiveness of the OSCE,

Taking into account Permanent Council Decision No. 705 of 1 December 2005 on the Common Regulatory Management System (CRMS), and striving to contribute to strengthening the efficiency, effectiveness and transparency of the OSCE,

Taking into account Permanent Council Decision No. 1216 of 21 July 2016 on amending OSCE Staff Regulations and the recommendations contained therein,

Underlining the importance of the oversight of the OSCE's administrative and financial activities exercised by the participating States, and recalling Permanent Council Decision No. 552 of 27 June 2003, setting out the responsibilities of the Advisory Committee on Management and Finance (ACMF),

Taking into consideration financial constraints faced currently by the participating States and reiterating that any request for a supplementary budget during a financial year shall be met, wherever reasonable, by reallocating existing resources,

Recalling Permanent Council Decision No. 1288 of 15 February 2018, establishing a special fund for the purpose of carrying out observation of local elections in certain areas of the Donetsk and Luhansk regions of Ukraine, and

Bearing in mind the previous discussions on horizontal issues and their outcomes, including the Augmentations Fund, the board and lodging allowance (BLA), local staff income tax, the secondment system as well as the budget cycle, as a separate issue,

1. Undertakes to continue efforts, including throughout the Unified Budget cycle in 2020, to focus, streamline and prioritize the work of the OSCE across the three dimensions in those areas where it has comparative advantage;
2. Tasks the Secretariat and the ACMF to continue efforts to improve further the programme and budget planning process and the evaluation process within the OSCE in order to increase efficiency, transparency and accountability;
3. Tasks the Secretariat and the ACMF to conduct an assessment of the new BLA methodology at the end of the first year of implementation in line with Permanent Council Decision No. 1305;
4. Tasks the fund managers to ensure full compliance of their programme activities with respective mandates and with the body of the OSCE principles, commitments and decisions;
5. Tasks all fund managers to distribute an open-ended list of Unified Budget projects to be undertaken and funded within the 2020 Unified Budget. The project list may be further supplemented by the fund managers within their respective funds, as appropriate, and an updated list should be issued to participating States once a year;
6. Tasks the Secretariat to amend Financial Administrative Instruction No. 9 on OSCE official travel management to reduce travel costs in line with PC.ACMF/111/18.

**INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT UNDER

By the delegation of Kazakhstan:

“Thank you, Mr. Chairperson.

In connection with the adoption of the decision on the approval of the 2020 OSCE Unified Budget, the delegation of Kazakhstan would like to make the following interpretative statement under paragraph IV.1(A)6 of the OSCE Rules of Procedure:

We emphasize the importance of adopting the OSCE Unified Budget for 2020 as early as possible in order to ensure the Organization’s smooth functioning. In view of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the activities of the OSCE executive structures and the savings that may result from the cancellation or deferral of some of those activities, we call for a review of the Unified Budget to be organized later in the year.

Over the past three years Kazakhstan has been promoting the idea of the First President of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Nursultan Nazarbayev, to foster the Organization’s presence in the Eurasian part of the OSCE area, in particular through the initiative to establish an OSCE thematic centre on sustainable connectivity.

In accordance with Regulation 2.08 of the OSCE Financial Regulations, ‘Decisions involving Additional Expenditures’ (DOC.PC/1/96 of 27 June 1996), the delegation of Kazakhstan proposed to include in the draft decision on the 2020 Unified Budget a reference to the discussion, within the OSCE, of the aforementioned initiative. That proposal demonstrates the transparent, constructive and flexible approach taken by Kazakhstan in the framework of the OSCE.

We regret that, despite receiving overwhelming support from participating States for the idea of promoting connectivity in the OSCE area, our proposal to include the reference to the discussion on an OSCE thematic centre on sustainable connectivity in the draft decision on the 2020 Unified Budget did not find consensus.

We firmly believe that strengthening the second dimension can serve as a confidence-building measure at a time of growing mistrust among participating States, and as an effective tool for making our societies and economies more resilient to crises and tackling new challenges, especially in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.

For the sake of reaching consensus, Kazakhstan withdrew its proposal on the text of the draft decision on the 2020 Unified Budget. We express our gratitude to the Albanian Chairmanship for its readiness to launch a discussion process on the establishment of an OSCE thematic centre on sustainable connectivity.

We are convinced that such thematic centres will be a key element in the OSCE's future work. We would urge participating States to become actively involved in the aforementioned discussion process.

I request that this interpretative statement be attached to the decision and to the journal of the day.

**INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT UNDER  
PARAGRAPH IV.1(A)6 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE  
OF THE ORGANIZATION FOR SECURITY AND  
CO-OPERATION IN EUROPE**

By the delegation of the Russian Federation:

“Having joined the consensus regarding the Permanent Council decision on the approval of the 2020 OSCE Unified Budget, the Russian Federation notes the following.

We regret that some OSCE participating States, including the principal contributors to its budget, continue to impose a policy of zero nominal growth on the Secretariat’s expenditure without taking into account its real needs in terms of resources. Adherence to this line over a period of many years, together with a refusal to take into account the consequences of inflation and exchange rate fluctuations, leads to a reduction in the purchasing power of the budget allocations. It jeopardizes the implementation of mandates in such crucial fields of OSCE activity as conflict resolution, countering new challenges and threats, and developing economic co-operation.

We believe that a correction in the balance in the allocation of resources between the three dimensions of security is long overdue. This should be achieved, first of all, by optimizing the excessive outlay on the needs of the humanitarian sphere. The savings made should be reallocated to non-military aspects of security and to the economic and environmental basket.

Additional effort is required with a view to increasing transparency and accountability in the use of funds provided by donors. We trust that the practice of informing participating States about the implementation of extrabudgetary projects by the institutions and field presences will be continued.

In our view, double standards and unilateral approaches in the work of the executive structures and field missions are unacceptable. They should take account of the opinions and concerns of all participating States in equal measure and in an inclusive manner. We reaffirm once again our call on the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights to improve its election observation methodology and practice, which should be based on the agreed principles and rules for election monitoring. We are disappointed at the lack of progress on this matter over many years.

OSCE programmes and projects should be fully in line with the approved mandates. It is unacceptable to include in them types of activities on which there is no consensus among

the participating States. It applies particularly to security sector governance and reform. We intend to return to this matter when considering the budget requests of individual field operations for 2021.

One participating State continues, as it did last year, to attempt to link the approval of the budget proposal with the reform of the Scales of Contributions. We regard this as unfounded, counter-productive and not in the interests of the Organization. Such behaviour results in delays in the adoption of the Unified Budget, which creates obstacles to the smooth planning and implementation of OSCE programmatic activities.

We request that this statement be appended to the adopted decision and the journal of the day.”

**INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT UNDER

The delegation of Croatia, in its capacity as EU Presidency, passed the floor to the representative of the European Union, who delivered the following statement:

“The Member States of the European Union welcome the adoption of the OSCE Unified Budget for 2020. They recognize the difficulty of this exercise and reiterate their support to the Albanian Chairmanship in implementing it.

The EU Member States, whose contributions account for 60 per cent of our Organization’s budget, remain committed to providing the Organization with adequate resources so that it can implement its comprehensive approach to security.

This budget represents a cautious approach by the participating States in a difficult economic situation as a result of the COVID-19 crisis. We recall in this context our firm support for better management of the costs of the Organization, including the Secretariat, and call for greater cost management efforts. However, this budget does not reflect all of the priorities of the EU Member States. We reiterate our full support for the mandates of the field missions and the three autonomous institutions and stress the importance and priority that we attach to their being provided with appropriate human and financial resources for them to carry out their mandates properly.

We recall that the human dimension is at the core of the OSCE’s mandate and is indispensable for its accomplishment. The credits allocated to the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights are still much too low given the current issues and challenges. The scope for action of the Office in Warsaw remains inadequate, particularly in the area of election observation. We reiterate our support for the existing election observation methodology. It should not be called into question on account of budgetary constraints. We remain determined to continue our efforts in that regard.

The Representative on Freedom of the Media should receive more resources in view of the growing number of issues justifying his intervention.

The EU Member States will continue to promote gender equality in all of the OSCE’s activities. We support the allocation of sufficient resources for implementing this principle. We stress the importance of a gender policy in the OSCE and the crucial role that women can

play at all levels of the decision-making process, including the peace processes and mediation.

We are willing to support the financing of investments in essential infrastructures through cash surpluses, insofar as such investments generate substantial savings in the future. We are not convinced, however, that these surpluses should or can be used systematically to cover expenses incurred through the OSCE's main activities within the Unified Budget.

The EU Member States will continue to place qualified personnel at the OSCE's disposal. We shall pay close attention to ensuring that the implementation of the new methodology for calculating board and lodging allowances is reviewed with account taken of the ongoing reform of the secondment system.

The discussion of the 2020 budget has also once again demonstrated the urgent need to find a solution for the Augmentations Fund with account taken of the financial arrangement adopted by the participating States regarding their level of contribution. We reiterate our support for the continued transfer of the posts concerned to the scale for the Secretariat.

We look forward to a rapid solution to the question of reimbursement from the Unified Budget of taxes levied by certain participating States on the income of local mission staff, all the more so as Uzbekistan has made a responsible choice, which we welcome again, to comply with its commitments in this area and to settle its outstanding payments to our Organization.

Finally, we wish to reiterate our commitment to making the necessary improvements to cost-sharing among participating States. Since the expiry of the Scales of Contributions in December 2017, only provisional or temporary solutions have been adopted. The efforts by the Albanian Chairmanship to find a lasting solution, which we welcome, should be continued so that a consensus, which remains essential, can be achieved as quickly as possible.

We request that this statement be appended to the adopted decision and included in the journal of the day.”

**INTERPRETATIVE STATEMENT UNDER

CO-OPERATION IN EUROPE**

By the delegation of Italy:

“Thank you, Mr. Chairperson.

Italy wishes to make an interpretative statement under paragraph IV.1(A)6 of the OSCE Rules of Procedure.

In joining the consensus on the OSCE 2020 Unified Budget, Italy is once again displaying, to the fullest possible extent, a sense of pragmatism, realism and responsibility. During more than seven months of negotiation, Italy explicitly supported the Albanian Chairmanship and its five different Unified Budget Proposals, even though those proposals became increasingly remote from our national interests and important elements, which had featured high on our priorities, were dropped.

On 18 May 2020, a new draft decision was distributed in which the expansion of the title of the post of ‘Director of the Office of the Secretary General’ to include the additional words ‘Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat’ was retracted. Italy had clearly expressed its position on this issue several times and, aware of the divergence of opinions among the participating States, asked for a compromise solution.

Italy would like to recall the background to this issue and restate some of the arguments in support of its position.

On 23 and 24 July 2019, the Secretariat issued vacancy notices for, respectively, the posts of Director of the Office of the Secretary General and Director of the Conflict Prevention Centre, both of which were additionally entitled ‘Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat’. In the former case, this involved a retitling of the post of Director of the Office of the Secretary General, in which various relevant practices and instructions were taken into account – notably Financial/Administrative Instruction No. 2, paragraph 5.9, which provides that the retitling of a post ‘can be performed by the Fund Managers in consultation with the Secretariat, without the formal approval of the Permanent Council’.

More than 150 candidates from numerous participating States, including Italy, applied for the post of Director of the Office of the Secretary General/Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat.

At the end of September 2019, the 2020 Unified Budget Proposal was distributed, in which the titles of the two Director posts were reflected as in the aforementioned vacancy notices. During the ensuing debate at the Permanent Council, some delegations raised the possibility of downgrading the post of Director of the Conflict Prevention Centre from D2 to D1.

In the first half of November 2019, the candidates shortlisted for the position of Director of the Office of the Secretary General were invited to interviews, which took place on 20 November 2019. In due course, the appointment of the Director of the Office of the Secretary General/Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat was formally announced on 11 December 2019.

On 13 December 2019, at a meeting of the Advisory Committee on Management and Finance (ACMF), two delegations questioned the change in the title of the Director of the Office of the Secretary General, in particular the additional words ‘Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat’.

We believe that the expansion of the original title to ‘Director of the Office of the Secretary General/Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat’, which does not have any budgetary implications, is justified and necessary for various reasons, including the following:

1. It is common practice for the heads of organizations – especially organizations of a certain category – to rely on two or more deputies. This reflects the need to divide the areas of competence of the head of the organization so that the deputies really are able to provide added value to its management. A similar practice is already encountered within the OSCE itself – for example, in the Special Monitoring Mission to Ukraine, the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights and many of the Secretariat’s departments;
2. The retitling formalizes and reflects the additional duties already being fulfilled by the Director of the Office of the Secretary General;
3. The retitling responds to a clear necessity raised by the Secretary General, Mr. Thomas Greminger, who was designated by the Ministerial Council and who, pursuant to the Staff Regulations and Staff Rules, is accountable in his role as chief administrative officer of the Organization to the Permanent Council. The Secretary General’s recommendations should be taken into serious consideration and overruled only for valid reasons. No such reasons could be heard by Italy.

Italy rejects the opinion that the vacancy was issued in violation of the relevant Financial Regulations. That opinion was also rejected by the OSCE Office of Legal Affairs, which confirmed that ‘in assigning the title of Deputy Head of the Secretariat to the Director of the Office of the Secretary General, the Common Regulatory Management System or standard process has not been breached by the Secretary General/Secretariat’.

In particular, Italy cannot agree with the view that Financial/Administrative Instruction No. 2, paragraph 5.9, is inconsistent with the Financial Regulations for the following reasons:

- The Financial Regulations do not provide any definition of ‘post table’, nor do they specify what the table should include. Therefore, Financial/Administrative Instruction No. 2 provides an essential interpretation of what ‘post table’ entails at the OSCE. In particular, the Instruction distinguishes between actions that do require approval by the Permanent Council, such as the establishment and abolition of posts or the regrading of posts, and actions that do not require such approval, including changes to the title of a post.
- The Financial/Administrative Instructions are the third layer of the Common Regulatory Management System. Before issuing an Instruction, the Secretariat must inform the ACMF and also consult participating States, should this be requested by one or more of them. Financial/Administrative Instruction No. 2 was not challenged by participating States at the time of its issuance or later, which means that they have accepted the interpretation given to the ‘post table’ concept by the Instruction.
- This interpretation is in line with the practice common to several international organizations, whose post tables specify only the ‘posts’ and their ‘classification’ (D2, D1, P5 and so on) and departmental affiliation. Even more telling is the example of international organizations whose governing bodies do not adopt any post table whatsoever as part of the budget.
- There are precedents within the OSCE which prove, *a fortiori*, that the standard process as envisaged by the Common Regulatory Management System was not breached in retitling the post of Director of the Office of the Secretary General. For instance: on 31 August 2017, the vacancy of Director for Management and Finance was advertised as a D1 post, even though in the post table adopted by the Permanent Council on 1 June 2017 the position had been classified as D2. The issuance of that vacancy notice could have implied a violation of the Financial Regulations, since what was at stake there was not the title but the classification of the post. Yet, no objections were raised either to the vacancy or to the appointment.

Furthermore, the Financial Regulations and Financial Rules do not lay down any specific consequences in the event of anomalies in the procedure. In this case, it is impossible to argue that the alleged anomaly in the procedure should automatically lead to revocation of the expanded title. On the contrary, in dealing with the alleged anomaly it is important to consider other aspects, such as the interests of the participating States that took part in good faith in the selection process for the position of Director of the Office of the Secretary General.

In conclusion, Italy maintains that one key argument should have been taken into account from the outset: over 150 candidates, including those sponsored by many of the participating States now objecting to the expanded title, applied for the post. No public objections were raised during the selection process, in which the majority of participating States evidently took part in good faith.

This good faith, which is crucial to the functioning of the Organization, should be preserved in future discussions on this topic.

I request that this interpretative statement be attached to the decision and to the journal of the day.

“Mr. Chairperson,

Albania wishes to make an interpretative statement under paragraph IV.1(A)6 of the Rules of Procedure of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe.

While thanking participating States for joining consensus for the adoption of the 2020 Unified Budget, Albania regrets that, despite over eight months of intense negotiations, participating States were only able to agree to what we see as a lowest-common denominator solution.

Albania notes that the position of the Director of the Office of the Secretary General was advertised and recruited under the post title ‘Director of the Office of the Secretary General/Deputy Head of the OSCE Secretariat’. Albania understands that there are different views among participating States as to whether such a procedure adhered to the OSCE Common Regulatory Management System. Albania commits to initiating an appropriate procedure to discuss the possible identification of another position tasked with deputizing for the Head of the OSCE Secretariat.

I would like to request that this statement be appended to the decision adopted, and included in the journal of the day.”

By the delegation of the United Kingdom:

“The United Kingdom welcomes the adoption of the OSCE 2020 Unified Budget. We would like to thank the Chairperson and his team for their tireless efforts in reaching a solution. It is essential that the OSCE is able to implement its mandate both effectively and efficiently, and we regret that it was not possible to reach a decision sooner.

The 2020 Unified Budget does not reflect all of our priorities. We would like to have seen more resources for the OSCE’s autonomous institutions and field operations, that add value on the ground. But we recognize at this late stage, and in light of the COVID-19 crisis, that the Budget on the table is the best we can achieve at this time and under these circumstances.

We would also like to stress the importance of building on some of the discussions that were started during the 2020 budget process, particularly as we move to the next budget cycle. This is specifically the case with respect to ‘ethics’.

We request that this statement be attached to the adopted decision and included in the journal of the day.”

By the delegation of France:

“France aligns itself with the interpretative statement by Croatia made on behalf of the European Union Member States.

France has joined the consensus subject to the following comments:

- The budget for the autonomous institutions remains inadequate. The autonomous institutions and field missions should have priority and receive significant financing;
- The savings and efficiency measures in the Secretariat are also inadequate. We support the establishment, as announced by Albania, of a working group to evaluate and reform the Secretariat and its functioning. We recall in this regard that the post table is an integral component of the budget and any change to it is subject to approval by consensus by the participating States at the end of the consultations, in accordance with OSCE Financial Regulation 2.07;
- The unusual and unjustified continuation of the Augmentations Fund, whose abolition has been demanded for too many years now, is unacceptable. France has ceased payment of the unduly invoiced amounts for this item. It urges the participating States to do likewise;
- In spite of the encouraging efforts by Uzbekistan, certain participating States continue to levy tax on the income of local OSCE mission staff, which is unacceptable. France has stopped paying the amounts invoiced for this item and urges the participating States to do likewise and the States concerned to follow the example of Uzbekistan;
- The new methodology for calculating the board and lodging allowance (BLA), which France has consistently opposed since its inclusion in the 2017 budget, remains subject to annual review, particularly in relation to the reform of the policy regarding the employment of seconded staff, which is closely linked with the BLA. France cannot accept a misuse of the secondment system that would turn the BLA into a remuneration package compensating for the failure of certain participating States to pay staff. We believe that this review should be proposed this year by the Secretariat without further delay, in accordance with the commitments undertaken since 2017.

The failure to conduct a review in 2019 already showed harmful disregard for these commitments and must not be repeated this year;

- The cash surplus should be returned to the participating States in accordance with the Financial Regulations. As an exception, it could be used for well-documented and agreed priorities;
- Finally, in spite of the efforts by the Albanian Chairmanship, which we welcome and support, the Organization has been without Scales of Contributions since 31 December 2019, with just temporary solutions being in place since 31 December 2017. We urge all participating States to act responsibly and to accept a fairer distribution of the financial burden of this Organization. It is not acceptable for 17 participating States alone to finance 99 per cent of the OSCE Budget. It is also inconceivable for an international organization such as the OSCE to function in the long term without an agreement on the Scales of Contributions that more widely reflect the participating States' capacity to pay. In reality, the opposition as a matter of principle by some participating States to increasing their contributions by a few hundred euros demonstrates the absence by them of political commitment and a profound lack of consideration for the security stakes in Europe and of our Organization, which addresses them. With COVID-19 affecting all of our economies and ultimately our security, it is high time for these participating States to take a responsible decision in line with the challenges we will have to face. In that regard, we continue our support for the activities of the Informal Working Group on Scales of Contributions.
