Malta's legal framework is in place with regard to the prohibition of the use, production, storage, transfer and destruction of anti-personnel landmines through the National Interest Enabling Powers Act, (Chap. 365) and the Military Equipment (Export Control) Regulations. No moratorium was introduced.**

<sup>1</sup> Notes on using the cover page:

1.
