On the terrorist attack in Turkey

Mr. Chairperson,

We express our deepest condolences and sympathy to the entire Turkish people, particularly the families of those killed in the deplorable terrorist attack in Ankara on 10 October 2015. We wish a speedy recovery to all those who suffered at the hands of the terrorists.

In a telegram to Mr. Recep Erdoğan, President of the Republic of Turkey, Russian President Vladimir Putin resolutely condemned this barbaric crime, which he regarded as an attempt to destabilize a country that is our friend and neighbour, and expressed the hope that the perpetrators and masterminds of this crime would receive the punishment they deserve. He also stressed that terrorism could be combated effectively only by the concerted efforts and active co-ordination of the international community as a whole in the framework of a broad international anti-terrorist coalition.
