OBSTACLES

- Lack of awareness and experience
- No central database for bank accounts (35)
- ➤ No central database for land registry (22 regional office)
- > No direct access certain financial database
- Burden of proof
- > Absence of alternative confiscation methods
- > Priorities of police chiefs
